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The fast will begin on Sunday, January 3, 2021 @ 11:00PM

Fasting in January is the First Fruit of our relationship with God. It sets the tone and foundation for a Blessed Year!!! God is in covenant with His people. But too often, we experience trials and situations that dulls our relationship with Him and disconnects us from His promises. But fasting puts us back on track! It strengthens our spirit, gives us a greater sense of peace, allows us to hear and see God more clearly, positions us to receive what God has for us, brings us into a more intimate relationship with the Father and adds Supernatural Power to our prayers! Fasting is an essential and necessary part of being a Breakthrough Believer!

Why Do We Fast?

To Receive Deliverance & Healing (2 Chronicles 7:14)

If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

(Isaiah 58:6-9)

"Is not this the fast that I choose: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the straps of the yoke, to let the oppressed go free, and to break every yoke? "Is not this the fast that I choose: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the straps of the yoke, to let the oppressed^[b] go free, and to break every yoke? ⁷ Is it not to share your bread with the hungry and bring the homeless poor into your house; when you see the naked, to cover him, and not to hide yourself from your own flesh? ⁸ Then shall your light break forth like the dawn, and your healing shall spring up speedily; your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard. ⁹ Then you shall call, and the Lord will answer; you shall cry, and he will say, 'Here I am.'

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It Gives Us Power: (Mark 9:26-29)

The spirit shrieked, convulsed him violently and came out. The boy looked so much like a corpse that many said, "He's dead." But Jesus took him by the hand and lifted him to his feet, and he stood up. After Jesus had gone indoors, his disciples asked him privately, "Why couldn't we drive it out?" He replied, "This kind can come out only by prayer and fasting.

Eight Benefits of Fasting:

- Fasting causes us to Rely on God
- Fasting Strengthens our Spirit and brings our flesh under subjection
- Fasting Helps us to be filled with the Fruits of the Spirit
- Fasting Opens our Heart to Hear God's Voice
- Fasting Renews our Appreciation for God and His Blessings
- Fasting Gives Power to our Prayers
- Fasting Creates an Environment for Miracles
- Fasting helps us to Consume God's Word

We Must Have the Proper Attitude towards Fasting (Mathew 6:16-18)

When you fast, do not look somber as the hypocrites do, for they disfigure their faces to show others they are fasting. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full. But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, so that it will not be obvious to others that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen; and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

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The Fast Is For the Body, Soul and Spirit

The Bible teaches us that we are a spirit, we have a soul and we live in a body. Our body is our earth suit. As we enter into a time of intentional prayer and fasting, it will affect all three parts; our body, soul and spirit.

The Body - As you change your diet you may experience headaches, leg cramps, and/or fatigue. These symptoms are a result of detoxing from caffeine, chemicals and sugar. They usually subside after the third day.

The Soul - Frequently referred to as "the flesh" in the Bible, the soul is also greatly impacted during Fasting. The soul is the seat of our emotions, intellect, personality and will. It is in the "soulish realm" where we experience cravings, frustration, anger and happiness. When you fast, your soul may very well rebel against the dramatic change in your diet. Experiencing and winning this battle over the flesh is often one of the most powerful lessons when Fasting!

The Spirit - Our spirit is that born-again part of us that surrenders to GOD. Our spirit is filled with the Holy Spirit when we yield to Him. During this Fast, we want to put our spirit in charge and in control of our body and soul.

Fast Friendly Reminders

Remember, a fast without prayer and meditation is just simply a diet. Fasting is always coupled with a spiritual goal. So during this time of fasting, focus on prayer, study and meditate (think deeply or carefully about something) on the Word of GOD.

Apostle Clarence & Pastor Robyn Langston along with Word In Action Christian Center International advise all who participates in this consecration/fast to consider your personal health needs and consult with your physician prior to beginning this fast.

Remember that during this time we are dedicating the first of the month to honor GOD with prayer, supplication, thanksgiving and our first fruits.

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What is First Fruits and Why Is It Important?

Seek ye first the kingdom of GOD...... (Mathew 6:33)

It is a Scriptural fact that GOD claims the right to every first- the first of the crops, every firstborn male herds, flocks and male child. Exodus 13:11-13 says:

"After the Lord brings you into the land of the Canaanites and gives it to you, as he promised on oath to you and your ancestors, you are to give over to the Lord the first offspring of every womb. All the firstborn males of your livestock belong to the Lord. Redeem with a lamb every firstborn donkey, but if you do not redeem it, break its neck. Redeem every firstborn among your sons."

Dedicating the first of the year to seek GOD's face and to bring Him the first of your increase, whether it be the first month or the first week's pay, is a kingdom principle that is done according to your faith. This kingdom principle establishes the law of firsts in your life because it activates the promise of what is to come. It positions you to receive the promises of GOD.

The first fruits offerings signal the beginning of the harvest for GOD's people and it governs and set the pattern of what is to come. First fruits offerings are not only an offering, but also a Promise of Abundance. GOD gave us His first fruit when He gave us His only begotten Son that whosoever believes in Him shall not perish but shall have everlasting life. (*John 3:16*) In Him giving us His first fruit it is a Promise of Abundance.

As we follow the directives of the fast, seek GOD first by dedicating the first of the month to push back our plates, meet daily for prayer, feed on His Word and bring Him the first of our increase we too set the pattern to receive the Promise of Abundance.

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GUIDELINES:

1. Corporate Prayer will be held on Facebook Live from 7:00 pm - 8:00 pm.

2. No television, secular radio, or entertainment. We are feeding our spirit by listening to worship and spiritual teaching CD's. (limit or refrain from listening to gospel music)

3. No casual conversation at work or on the telephone. (Work related conversations will be permitted.)

5. No social media i.e. Facebook, TikTok, Twitter, Instagram, YouTube, Snap Chat, etc.

6. FOCUS on studying the Word and related Christian books and materials.

7. Pray 3 times a day on the daily prayer targets

Suggested Prayer times: 9:00 am, Noon & 3:00pm. If you are unable to pray at these times, replace it with a prayer time that is feasible for your schedule.

8. Married people should abstain from sexual relations. (Seek the consent of your spouse if your spouse is not a Word In Action Disciple and is not participating in the consecration).

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EATING GUIDELINES:

Water and one (1) meal per day between 5PM - 8PM. If necessary, you may have 100% grape, apple, or orange juice. Do NOT consume any sugar, sweeteners, diet pop, sweets or caffeine.

Again, as you plan your meal and eat your food, keep in mind that the definition of a fast is to deny food for a spiritual purpose and not as a means to lose weight.

PLEASE NOTE:

Fasting and your health: If you have concerns about your physical ability to fast, please consult a physician before beginning this fast. There are different types of fasts. Your doctor can provide advice on how you can participate on the fast in a way that is healthy for you.

Children and fasting: This fast is not intended for children under the age of 14. Teenagers between the ages of 14-18 may participate if they and their parents feel led to do so. If you decide not to have your children/teenager participate on the fast, some ideas for sacrifice would be to eliminate video games or cell phone usage during the fast.

This is a corporate fast. Therefore, to ensure that we are on one accord a guide has been provided. The guide includes daily activities, prayer targets, key scriptures, definitions, and declarations. Please read the daily declarations out loud.

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DAY 1: MONDAY, January 4th REPENTANCE AND FORGIVENESS TOWARDS GOD, SELF AND OTHERS

Today is a Heart & Self Check Day! We are repenting from our sins and asking God to forgive us for anything in our lives that displease Him as well as for anything we have done to others.

Repentance - a change of mind; turning from one way of thinking and behaving to God's way.

Forgiveness - a conscious, deliberate decision to release feelings of resentment or vengeance toward a person who has harmed you, regardless of whether they actually deserve your forgiveness.

In order to be positioned to receive GOD's RESTORATION we must always have an attitude of FORGIVENESS. Satan is the accuser of the brethren. He stands before GOD telling Him our sins, our faults, and our shortcomings. He also tries to make us feel guilty for things that we may have done, said or thought. It is imperative that we do not condemn ourselves. We must forgive ourselves for our shortcomings because GOD HAS ALREADY FORGIVEN US; When we have truly repented, God cast our sins into the sea of forgetfulness to never remember them again. He no longer holds our sins against us so we are free from condemnation.

Prayer:

Father, I repent and overcome everything that has hindered me from walking in your Promises. I repent for sins that I have knowingly committed and sins that I have unknowingly committed. As I come with a humble and true heart of repentance, I know you forgive me and that I am free from condemnation. I receive the knowledge and freedom that true repentance brings.

I understand that if I am to receive your promises, I must forgive. I have not always done what was right but your mercy is everlasting. So I thank you for forgiving me for the things that I've done towards you and others. Just as you have forgiven me, I freely forgive others. I will not go back to an old way of thinking! I will not look back and pick up old habits! I am moving forward in your will and your way! In Jesus name, Amen!

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Key Scriptures: 2 Chronicles 7:14, 2 Peter 3:9, Acts 3:19, Psalms 32:5, Matthew 6:14-15

2 Chronicles 7:14 (NKJV)

If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

2 Peter 3:9 (NKJV)

The Lord is not slack concerning His Promises, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

DAY 2: TUESDAY, January 5th LOVE FOR GOD, SELF AND OTHERS

Today we are asking God to give us His perfect love for Him, ourselves and for others. It's only when we receive God's perfect love that we can truly love Him, ourselves and others.

Love - is patient and kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice in wrongdoing but rejoices in the truth; Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never ends..." (1 Corinthians 13:4-8)

Prayer:

Lord give me more love for you, myself and others! Fill me with so much of your Agape love that I exude your love in every area of my life. I want to display your love to every person I come in contact with. When I love you more, I know I will be able to see everyone and everything through your Love! In Jesus name, Amen!

Key Scriptures: Mark 12:30-31, 1 John 4:20

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DAY 3: WEDNESDAY, January 6th Hunger for Souls and A Heart To Evangelize

Souls are the heartbeat of God. Therefore, we are asking God to give us a sincere hunger and thirst for souls and desire to evangelize for Him. God sent His only Son to die so that ALL could have an opportunity to receive His salvation. He wants us to be excited about His gift of salvation and eternal life and to share His promise with others. So today we are focusing on defeating the enemy's camp by winning souls for the Kingdom of God!

Hunger - a strong or compelling desire or craving

Thirsty - an eagerness, longing or need to quench

Evangelism - the practice of sharing the love of God and giving information about Jesus Christ to others

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Prayer:

Lord give me a heart for winning souls so that the promises I have so freely received, through your son Jesus Christ, others can receive as well. Allow my light to shine so brightly that others will want to know about the God I serve. Give me the words to say that will compel others to come to you and I will give you all the honor and the praise. In Jesus name, Amen!

Key Scriptures: Matthew 28:19, Proverbs 11:30, Matthew 9:37-38

Matthew 28:19 (NKJV)

¹⁹Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

Proverbs 11:30 (NKJV)

³⁰The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and he who wins souls is wise.

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Matthew 9:37-38 (NKJV)

⁷ Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly *is* plentiful, but the laborers *are* few. ³⁸ Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."

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DAY 4: THURSDAY, January 7th HUNGER FOR THE WORD

Today we are asking God to give us a hunger and a thirst for His Word. Matt 4:4 says, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God". Much like natural food provides and supplies nutrients for us to grow physically, God's Word provides the spiritual nutrients we need to grow spiritually.

Hunger - a strong or compelling desire or craving

Desire - a strong feeling of wanting to have something or wishing for something to happen.

Prayer:

Lord give me a desire for your Word! Open up my heart, mind and understanding to receive more of your Word. Give me a sincere hunger and thirst for you and your Word. Give me eyes to see you clearly and ears to hear you clearly. Let your Word lead and guide me in every area of my life. I surrender myself to you and your Word. In Jesus name, Amen!

Action:

Make a daily commitment to set aside a specific time to read/feed on God's Word. Commit to this daily time even after the fast is over and watch God's Word manifest in your life.

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Key Scriptures: 1 Peter 2:1-3, John 1: 1-3

1 Peter 2:1-3 (NKJV)

Therefore, laying aside all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, ² as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby, ³ if indeed you have tasted that the Lord *is* gracious.

John 1: 1-3 (NKJV)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with GOD, and the Word was GOD. ² He was in the beginning with GOD. ³ All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

<u>Suggested Scripture Reading:</u> *Psalms 119:9-11, Psalms 119:89, Psalms 119: 105, Joshua 1:7-8*

Action:

Make a daily commitment and set aside a time that you will feed on GOD's Word. Commit to this time daily even after the fast is over.

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DAY 5: FRIDAY, January 8th GOD's GUIDANCE AND WISDOM

God's Word says if we lack wisdom, we can ask Him and He'll give it to us because He very generously gives to all men without finding fault. How awesome is that!!! He also gave us the Holy Spirit to lead and guide us. Matthew 21:22 says "And whatever you ask in prayer, you will receive, if you have faith." So, today we are asking God to guide us and give us more wisdom.

Wisdom - knowing how to apply knowledge, the ability to think and act utilizing knowledge, experience, understanding, common sense and insight.

Guidance - the act or function of guiding; leadership, direction, advice or counseling, supervised care or assistance.

Prayer:

Lord, so many times I have acted without wisdom and it has caused me to experience hardships my life. Your Word says if I lack wisdom, I can ask you and you will generously give it to me without finding fault. So I ask you for a generous portion of your wisdom in every area of my life and I thank you for answering my prayer. I understand that as I act in your wisdom, I am acknowledging you because I am not leaning to my own understanding. I am being lead by your Holy Spirit and positioning myself for your promotion. In Jesus name, Amen!

Key Scriptures: Proverbs 9:10-11, James 1: 2-8

Promise - a declaration or assurance that one will do a particular thing or that a particular thing will happen.

Covenant - the conditional promises made to humanity by God, as revealed in God's Word.

Prayer:

Lord, prepare my heart to receive all of your promises to me. I know that you will reward those who diligently seek you and that you are the one who promotes us. I seek you in every area of my life and I thank you for your supernatural promotion. Position me to walk in the fullness of your promises. Help me to remain humble because I know that you are the one who brings down one and exalts another. It is only by your grace and mercy that I am promoted. So I thank you and praise you for my supernatural promotion and for fulfilling your promises for my life. In Jesus name, Amen!

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Key Scriptures: Matthew 6:31-33, John 14:1-3, Psalm 75:6-7, Colossians 3:23-24

Matthew 6:31-33 (NKJV)

So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

John 14:1-3 (NKJV)

Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in GOD; believe also in me. 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DAY 9: TUESDAY, January 12th RESTORATION IN MY HEART & MIND

God loved us way before we fell in love with Him. Throughout this year, we have given our hearts and minds to things, situations and people that have disappointed us and caused us to become distracted and even separate from Him. As we turn back to GOD, He is faithful and just to restore our hearts back to Him. So, today we are asking God for restoration in our hearts and minds so that we can fully experience His love, peace, joy and promises.

Restoration - the act of restoring; renewal, revival or reestablishment; the return of something to a former, original, normal or unimpaired condition; restitution of something taken away or lost.

Prayer:

Lord, thank you that your grace is sufficient and your power is made perfect in my weakness. Restore my heart and mind back to you. Give me the mind of Christ. Make every crooked place straight in my life. Restore me to my rightful position and place in you and give me the strength to never go back. I receive your restoration and thank you for blessing me naturally and spiritually. In Jesus name, Amen!

Key Scriptures: Ezekiel 36: 26-27, Philippians 4: 4-9

Ezekiel 36: 26-27 (NKJV)

²⁶ I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. ²⁷ I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in my statutes, and you will keep my judgments and do *them*.

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Philippians 4: 4-9 (NKJV)

⁴Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice! ⁵Let your gentleness be known to all men. The Lord *is* at hand. ⁶Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to GOD; and the peace of GOD, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. ⁸Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things *are* noble, whatever things *are* just, whatever things *are* pure, whatever things *are* lovely, whatever things *are* of good report, if *there is* any virtue and if *there is* anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. ⁹The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the GOD of peace will be with you.

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DAY 10: WEDNESDAY, January 13th Restoration in My Health and Finances
