2 Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.²¹ Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God,²² who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.

Isaiah 41:10 Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand.

Isaiah 26:3 You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you!

Deuteronomy 31:8 Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the Lord will personally go ahead of you. He will be with you; he will neither fail you nor abandon you."

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.
