## **DAY 2 | FORGIVENESS**

SEEKING GOD'S FORGIVENESS, FORGIVING OURSELVES, FORGIVING OTHERS Wednesday, January 10<sup>th</sup>

**Forgiveness**- to grant pardon for or remission of an offense, debt, etc. Today is a heart and self-check day! We are asking GOD for forgiveness for the actions in our lives that have displeased Him as well as for the things that we have done to others.

In order to be positioned to receive GOD's Open Door's in our lives we must always have an attitude of FORGIVENESS. Satan is the accuser of the brethren.
