

DAY 10 | Protection & Safety

Wednesday, January 15th

Today, we focus on protection and safety. We know that God is our refuge and stronghold, and today we pray for His divine protection over our lives, our families, and our loved ones. Let's trust in His faithfulness to keep us safe from harm and shield us from every danger.

Protection- a person or thing that prevents someone or something from suffering harm or injury.

God covers our heads on the day of battle according to Psalm 140:7. A covering is protection. Covering based on obedience to God, His Word, and the Holy Spirit.

Today we release God's divine protection, divine safety and divine covering over our first family, ourselves, families, extended families and friends. We remain fixed under and live under the shadow of God almighty according to *Psalms 91*. We loose guardian angels of protection, I cover myself, my family and my possessions with the blood of Jesus. Let the fire of God surround and protect my life from all destruction.

Decree today:

I cover the first family, their home, possessions and investments with the blood of Jesus.

I release legions of Guardian Angels to cover and encamp around them.

I plead the blood of Jesus over myself, my family, and my possessions.

Let the fire of God surround and protect my life from all destruction.

Let the Angel of the Lord encamp around me and protect me. *Psalms 34:7*

Let Your glory be my covering and protect my back.

Hold me up, and I will be safe. *Psalms 119:117*

The name of Jesus is a strong tower, I run into it and I am safe. *Proverbs 18:10*

I decree divine protection and I loose guardian Angels of protection over myself, my family, my friends, my community, my city and my nation in Jesus Name.

Lord be my defense and my refuge according to *Psalms 59:16*

I will dwell in safety under the Shadow of the Almighty all of my days In Jesus Name!

Father, surround me with Your shield of protection. *Psalms 5:12*

What is the definition of protection?

Protection is a person or thing that prevents harm or injury.

What is the basis of God's protection over us?

God's protection is based on our obedience to Him, His Word, and the Holy Spirit.

How can we activate God's protection over our lives?

By pleading the blood of Jesus over ourselves and our families, releasing guardian angels, and standing firm in the promises of God as stated in Psalm 91.

What does Psalm 91:7 say about God's protection?

Psalm 91:7 assures us that "A thousand may fall at your side, And ten thousand at your right hand; But it shall not come near you."

1. In what areas of my life do I need to trust God more for protection?
2. How can I remain under God's covering and strengthen my obedience to Him?
3. What are some ways I can pray for the protection and safety of others in my life?

Key Scriptures: [Psalms 91](#), [Psalms 17:8](#), [Isaiah 54:17](#), [2 Thessalonians 3:3](#), [Psalm 46:1](#), [Psalm 34:7](#), [Ezekiel 34:28](#)

Psalms 91 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.²I will say of the Lord, "*He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust.*"³Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler *And* from the perilous pestilence. ⁴He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth *shall be your* shield and buckler. ⁵You shall not be afraid of the terror by

night, *Nor* of the arrow *that* flies by day, ⁶ *Nor* of the pestilence *that* walks in darkness, *Nor* of the destruction *that* lays waste at noonday.⁷ A thousand may fall at your side, And ten thousand at your right hand; *But* it shall not come near you. ⁸ Only with your eyes shall you look And see the reward of the wicked. ⁹ Because you have made the Lord, *who is* my refuge, *Even* the Most High, your dwelling place,¹⁰ No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling; ¹¹ For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways. ¹² In *their* hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone. ¹³ You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, The young lion and the serpent you shall trample underfoot.¹⁴ “Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name.¹⁵ He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I *will be* with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him.¹⁶ With long life I will satisfy him, And show him My salvation.”

Psalms 17:8 Guard me as you would guard your own eyes. Hide me in the shadow of your wings.

Isaiah 54:17 But in that coming day no weapon turned against you will succeed. You will silence every voice raised up to accuse you. These benefits are enjoyed by the servants of the Lord; their vindication will come from me. I, the Lord, have spoken!

2 Thessalonians 3:3 But the Lord is faithful; he will strengthen you and guard you from the evil one.

Psalms 46:1 God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble.

Psalms 34:7 For the angel of the Lord is a guard; he surrounds and defends all who fear him.

Ezekiel 34:28 And they shall no longer be a prey for the nations, nor shall beasts of the land devour them; but they shall dwell safely, and no one shall make *them* afraid.

Suggested Scripture Reading: [Psalm 59:16](#), [Psalm 5:12](#), [Deuteronomy 31:6](#)

Psalm 59:16 But I will sing of Your power; Yes, I will sing aloud of Your mercy in the morning; For You have been my defense And refuge in the day of my trouble.

Psalm 5:12 For You, O Lord, will bless the righteous; With favor You will surround him as *with* a shield.

Deuteronomy 31:6 Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the Lord your God, He *is* the One who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you.”

Why do we fast?

Fasting is a spiritual discipline that helps us focus on God, break spiritual strongholds, and receive clarity, strength, and renewal.

Isaiah 58:6 “Is this not the fast that I have chosen: To loose the bonds of wickedness, To undo the heavy burdens, To let the oppressed go free, And that you break every yoke?

The power of prayer

Prayer connects us with God to bring about transformation and align our will with His.

James 5:16 The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.
