DAY 18 | Supernatural Abundance In my Finances

Thursday, January 23th

God desires for us to live in financial freedom and abundance, but that requires us to align our financial habits with His Word. Honoring Him with our finances through tithes, offerings, and stewardship opens the door for supernatural provision and blessings. When we move from a mindset of lack to one of abundance, we position ourselves to experience the overflowing blessings God has for us.

Prayer: Lord, I repent for the times that I have not brought you YOUR tithe! I acknowledge that Your WORD says in Proverbs 3:9-10 that if I honor you with my possessions and the first of my increase then you will increase me with plenty. I thank YOU that as I do what you have commanded I will experience supernatural abundance in my finances. I AM a money magnet and prosperity is drawn to me! I move from poverty thinking to abundance thinking! I give and it is given back to me a good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over into my bosom. Doors are open for me to walk into wealth and riches In Jesus Name! I AM open and receptive to all the wealth life offers me! I thank you for Supernatural Abundance in MY FINANCES!

1. What does the Bible say about honoring God with our finances?

Proverbs 3:9-10 teaches us to honor the Lord with the firstfruits of our increase, and in return, He promises abundance and overflowing blessings.

2. How can we move from poverty thinking to abundance thinking?

By meditating on God's promises and declaring them over our lives. Proverbs 10:22 reminds us that the blessing of the Lord makes us rich without adding sorrow.

3. What does giving unlock in our finances?

Luke 6:38 declares that when we give, it is given back to us—pressed down, shaken together, and running over. Generosity opens the door to God's overflow.

4. What is the source of our ability to create wealth?

Deuteronomy 8:18 reminds us that God gives us the power to get wealth to establish His covenant with us. Wealth comes from His blessing and guidance.

Point of Reflection:

Reflect on how you handle your finances and whether you are trusting God fully in this area.

Key Scriptures: Proverbs 3:9-10 Proverbs 10:22, Luke 6:38, Deuteronomy 8:18, Malachi 3:10, Matthew 6:33

Proverbs 3:9-10 Honor the Lord with your possessions, and with the firstfruits of all your increase; So your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine.

Proverbs 10:22 The blessing of the Lord, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it.

Luke 6:38 Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."

Deuteronomy 8:18 "And you shall remember the Lord your God, for *it is* He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as *it is* this day.

Malachi 3:10 "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the LORD Almighty, "and see if I

will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it."

Matthew 6:33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

Suggested Scriptures: *Philippians 4:19 Proverbs 15:16, Proverbs* 22:1

Philippians 4:19 And my God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Proverbs 15:16 Better *is* a little with the fear of the Lord, Than great treasure with trouble.

Proverbs 22:1 A *good* name is to be chosen rather than great riches, Loving favor rather than silver and gold.

Why do we fast?
